• GREAT THANKSGIVING

Christ, given for you...the blood of Christ, shed for you." Or "The body of Christ, the bread of heaven...the blood of Christ, the cup of salvation." After being served, it is appropriate to respond,

"Amen," "Alleluia! Amen" or "Thanks be to God."
